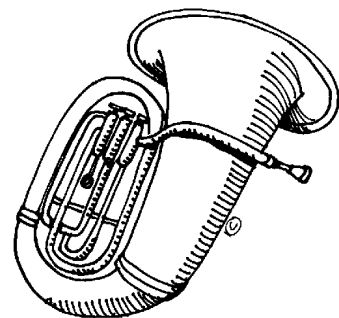
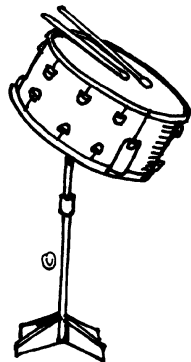

Common Questions

What is Solo and Ensemble Festival? This is an event where band students can play music that they have prepared for a judge. The judge gives them a score of 1, 2, 3, or 4 (1 being the highest).

Are the students rewarded for their performance? Yes, all students who participate get a certificate. Students who score a 1 or 2 will get a medal.

Is there any cost for this event? There is a registration fee of \$3.00 per student per event. Students are allowed to perform up to two pieces of music. If a student is playing twice, they will owe \$6.00 for registration.

When is the registration fee due? All fees are due to your band director by March 1st.

Are parents allowed to attend? Yes, parents and family are encouraged to attend the festival, and there is no cost to get in.

Can parents watch the students perform while they are being judged? No one else is allowed in the room while students are playing to be judged. Parents and friends can stand at the door to listen.

How long will the festival last? Judging starts at 5:00 PM and will end around 8:00-8:30. An exact schedule will be given out by Friday, March 4th. Students do **NOT** have to stay the entire time. They should show up about a half hour before their performance to warm up, and they are free to leave when they are finished.
